Prime Minister **Scott Morrison** ordered self-isolation on travellers arriving in the country



CANADA

stimulus package

Prime Minister Justin Trudeau announced that the country would be closing its borders to most non-Canadian



CHINA

■ 500 bil yuan (US\$71.2 bil)

reverse repos

The central government imposed a lockdown in Wuhan and other cities in Hubei province



FRANCE

■ €45 bil (US\$50 bil)

financial aid

President **Emmanuel Macron** announced severe restrictions to movement in the country and ordered people to stay at home



GERMANY

Chancellor Angela Merkel announced a shutdown of shops, churches, sports facilities, bars and clubs



HONG KONG

■ HK\$120 bil (US\$15.4 bil)

relief package

Chief Executive Carrie Lam Cheng Yuet-ngor said Hong Kong will put all visitors under a two-week guarantine and medical surveillance, but she will not order a complete lockdown



INDONESIA

stimulus package

President Joko Widodo said Indonesia has no plans yet for a lockdown, but the government is taking a "social distancing" approach by discouraging largescale gatherings



ITALY

■ €25 bil (US\$28.3 bil)

virus-related stimulus

Prime Minister Giuseppe Conte declared a nationwide lockdown



JAPAN

¥2.03 tril (US\$19.6 bil)

virus package

Prime Minister Shinzo Abe said there is no need to declare a state of emergency at this point

Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong imposed some travel restrictions for China, Iran, South Korea and Italy, but insists that Singapore is not locking down its city

The southern cities of Daegu and Cheongdo have been declared "special care zones", but the country has yet to impose massive lockdown

Imposing stricter

control measures for travellers from disease-infected zones, namely China, Hong Kong, Macau, South Korea, Italy and Iran

Prime Minister Boris Johnson said everyone should stop non-essential contact with others
